IMHO has been serving communities in need globally as an international humanitarian organization particularly in Sri Lanka. The efforts have been prioritized on developing and improving healthcare services and infrastructure and promoting the wellbeing of all persons including livelihood for the needy. About \$ 342,000 has been spent on program service expenses from January through the end of December, 2015 to facilitate healthcare development, livelihood, nutrition, and poor students' education in the underprivileged areas. throwing normal life out of gear. Several communities including Sri Lanka refugee camps were affected having lost crops/food, clothing, and shelter.

Responding to the crisis, IMHO got behind the emergency relief efforts of the local NGO SAWED Trust giving about \$10,300 to their efforts to help restore normalcy to their lives through provisions of relief packages containing nutritional support and other basic supplies. At least 385 families benefitted from the camps.

The core strength of IMHO is in filling critical gaps to provide holistic set of services and support to enhance patient care. The IMHO Board approved support for the following projects reflecting this unique capability:

2. Physiotherapy Equipment, DGH Mullaitivu	\$8,000
